RESPONSIBILITIES WILL INCLUDE, BUT NOT LIMITED TO:

- 1. Creating consistent, meaningful social media content that represents the brand message and personality of The Mix on our main social media platforms (Facebook, Instagram, IG Stories, and Twitter, TikTok)
- 2. Interacting with followers, local schools, and other accounts to keep engagement levels up.
- 3. Researching and assisting with the implementation of social media strategies that promote programs and raise awareness of The Mix.
- 4. Coordinating with the Marketing & Communications Team regarding social media analytics, growth strategies, etc.
- 5. Working with the Creative Team on various projects.

- 6. Using social media management tools such as Sprout, Hootsuite and Facebook Creator Studio.
- 7. Assisting with community outreach and special events as needed.
- 8. Staying up to date on best practices and emerging trends in social media.
